Made from 100% melamine, it offers strength and durability to meet the demands of a busy hospitality environment. Handling with care and following the guidelines below will help to prolong the life of your product.

#### USES

- Our melamine is dishwasher safe.
- For hand washing use a non-abrasive pad to avoid dulling the finish.
- Melamine is suitable for use in chilled and ambient temperatures.
- Melamine is suitable for hot and cold food use.
- Melamine is suitable for food storage at ambient or chilled temperatures for up to 24 hours.
- Wash melamine as soon as possible to avoid the possibility of staining. If staining occurs we advise using a high quality pre-soak dishwasher detergent. Contact your chemical specialist for further guidance.

## **MISUSES**

- X Not suitable for oven or microwave use.
- Do not expose melamine to direct flame or heat, including heat lamps and plate warmers.
- Melamine is not suitable for food preparation.
- Melamine is not suitable for hot counters, displays, or heated cabinets.
- Avoid the use of harsh chemicals such as chlorine based detergents or bleach and the use of harsh or abrasive scouring products.
- To avoid chipping and scratching, do not strike melamine products with or on any hard surface whilst attempting to remove any excess food.
- Melamine is not a suitable cutting surface as all melamine can scratch.
- Immediately remove chipped or damaged melamine from use.
